

Carriages

Carriages and Carriage Parts - There are 4 sizings of hook type blade carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for loads up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
