As opposed to the quick-tach bucket models, universal fit buckets are fifty percent. This additional space makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads such as broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel and moving large debris piles.

The Quick-Tach is able to pour items around 1.5 feet higher thanks to the shorter depth of its bucket.
